WHY: The AstraZeneca Hope Lodge Center in Boston, a program of the American Cancer Society, provides 40 guest suites in a supportive and home-like atmosphere where cancer patients and their families can stay free of charge for the duration of treatment.

The 50,000 square-foot facility is the third American Cancer Society Hope Lodge in New England; the others are located in Worcester, MA, and Burlington, VT. The Society currently operates 28 Hope Lodges nationwide, serving more than 20,000 cancer patients and their caregivers every year, with 20 more Hope Lodges in various stages of planning in cities across the U.S.
