SULTRY SUMMER TRIPLE PATIO LAUNCH PARTY AT INTERCONTINENTAL BOSTON ON JUNE 5, 2010
Seasonal Opening Party for Three Outdoor Waterfront Dining Venues

WHAT: InterContinental Boston’s Sultry Summer Triple Patio Launch Party is the official seasonal opening for **Sushi-Teq’s outdoor waterfront medallion**, **Miel “Brasserie Provençale’s” outdoor waterfront patio** and **Miel’s Terrace Wine Bar**. Located on Boston’s glistening waterfront along the Fort Point Channel, the evening will consist of a host of indoor and outdoor entertainment such as a live salsa band, salsa dancers, Capoeira dancers and tastings such as Sushi-Teq’s sushi and margaritas, Miel’s new summer flatbreads, (baked in the waterfront’s only outdoor waterfront clay-oven) and desserts. In addition, through the evening, a variety of vendors will be on hand offering tastings of everything from absinthe and champagne, to rums and liquors.

This party marks the official opening for **Miel’s outdoor waterfront patio** (seats 54) in addition to seasonal opening for **Miel’s Terrace Wine Bar** (seats 40) which will feature tastings of absinthe and fresh Provence-inspired flatbreads, from the new Bread Bar menu, which are baked-to-order in the waterfront’s only outdoor naan-style clay oven. Miel’s outdoor patio and Miel’s Terrace Wine Bar, serving Boston’s largest selection of rosé wines, will be open for service throughout the evening offering traditional Provence cuisine among lemon and lime trees and amidst planters filled with lavender, thyme, rosemary etc. and views of Boston’s glistening waterfront. Inside, Miel will feature a ‘French Tasting Room’ where guests can taste samples of Louis Latour wines, Grey Goose Vodka, Kronenbourg beer and a selection of champagnes. Throughout the season, Miel’s outdoor waterfront patio serves breakfast, lunch and dinner daily and Miel’s Terrace Wine Bar will be open every evening as of 5 p.m. from June through September 2010. The Bread Bar will be available every Thursday evening during the summer season.

Sushi-Teq’s outdoor waterfront medallion (seats 42) will also be officially opened for seasonal service offering lunch and dinner from June - September along the Fort Point Channel. Throughout the evening amidst potted palms and Miami-style lounge seating, Sushi-Teq will be offering margarita and hand roll tastings as well as serve Sushi-Teq’s full menu along side a full outdoor bar. A live salsa band and salsa dancers will be performing from 8 - 10 p.m. At 10 p.m. Capoeira dancers, an Afro-Brazilian art form that combines elements of martial arts, music, and dance, will begin performing.

Also at 10 p.m. **RumBa** will open its **Champagne Lounge** which will offer wide array of dessert tastings along with a variety of rums and liquors to taste. And, DJ CueTwo will be spinning tunes from 9 p.m. – 1:15 a.m. (last call) for an evening of lively dancing.
